We will notify you of the proposed audit dates for your agreement in due course.

This Authority may restrict, suspend, withdraw or revoke the approval should the organization fail to meet or comply with applicable requirements and established procedures or refrain from facilitating the conduct of inspection by the authorized inspectors, in pursuance to Article (40) of Law No.15 of 2002. Pending final approval, your proposed QCAA MOE Supplement Issue 01 Rev 00 dated 24 February 2026 is hereby provisionally approved for your implementation.
